What are door-to-door visits? \(\frac{1}{2} \)

Door-to-door visits are when police officers from normal or residential police boxes visit homes, businesses, and so on to listen to requests or to inform people about matters such as crime and accident prevention.

- ② Gathering contact information in case of a disaster, accident, or getting lost


In Akita Prefecture, with an increasing number of elderly residents, the card is used to help us return lost elderly to their families as soon as possible.
